



## Have you started thinking about Christmas yet ?

**Of course you have ! Here's a little help on some common mistakes we can hear at this time of year**

✗ 1. "For Happy New Year I go to my family."  
✓ Correct: "For New Year, I'm going to see my family."

➡ We see/visit family; we don't "go to my family."

✗ 2. "I pass the Christmas at home."

✓ Correct: "I spend Christmas at home."

➡ We **spend time**, not pass it.

✗ 3. "We celebrated the Christmas."

✓ Correct: "We celebrated Christmas."

➡ No "the" before holidays (Christmas, Easter, New Year's Eve, etc.)

✗ 4. "I hope you pass a good holiday."

✓ Correct: "I hope you have a good holiday."

➡ We **have** holidays.

✗ 5. "We will make a big party for New Year."

✓ Correct: "We will have/throw a big party for New Year's Eve."

➡ We **have** a party (informal) or throw a party (organise).

✗ 6. "I am in holidays."

✓ Correct: "I am **on** holiday." (UK) / "I'm on vacation." (US)

➡ "**On** holiday," not "in."
